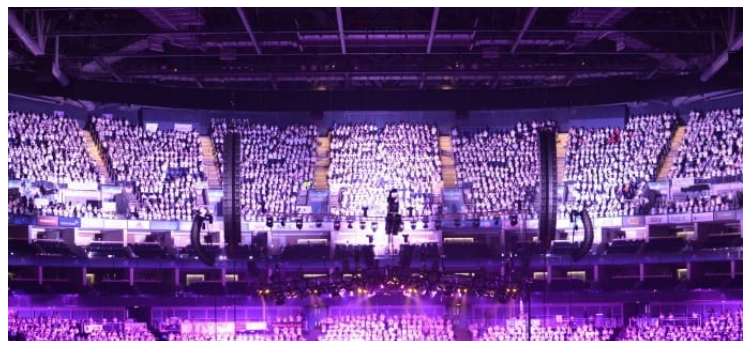
Young Voices at the O2 Arena – exciting opportunity!
